[RELEVANCE]

Collagen Type II is the basis for articular cartilage and hyaline cartilage. It makes up 50% of all protein in cartilage and 85-90% of collagen of articular cartilage. COL2 does form fibrils. This fibrillar network of collagen allows cartilage to entrap the proteoglycan aggregate as well as provide tensile strength to the tissue.

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[ANTIBODY SPECIFITY]

The antibody is a cavia polyclonal antibody raised against COL2. It has been selected for its ability to recognize COL2 in immunohistochemical staining and western blotting.

[APPLICATIONS]
