**Source:** Prokaryotic expression

**Host:** *E.coli*

**Residues:** Arg58~Ile239

**Tags:** N-terminal His Tag

**Subcellular Location:** Secreted

**Purity:** > 95%

**Traits:** Freeze-dried powder

**Buffer formulation:** PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% Sarcosyl, 5% Trehalose.

**Original Concentration:** 100µg/mL

**Applications:** Positive Control; Immunogen; SDS-PAGE; WB.

(May be suitable for use in other assays to be determined by the end user.)

**Predicted isoelectric point:** 9.4

**Predicted Molecular Mass:** 21.5kDa

**Accurate Molecular Mass:** 21kDa as determined by SDS-PAGE reducing conditions.

## **[ USAGE ]**

Reconstitute in ddH<sub>2</sub>O to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

## **[ STORAGE AND STABILITY ]**

**Storage:** Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 2-8°C for one month.

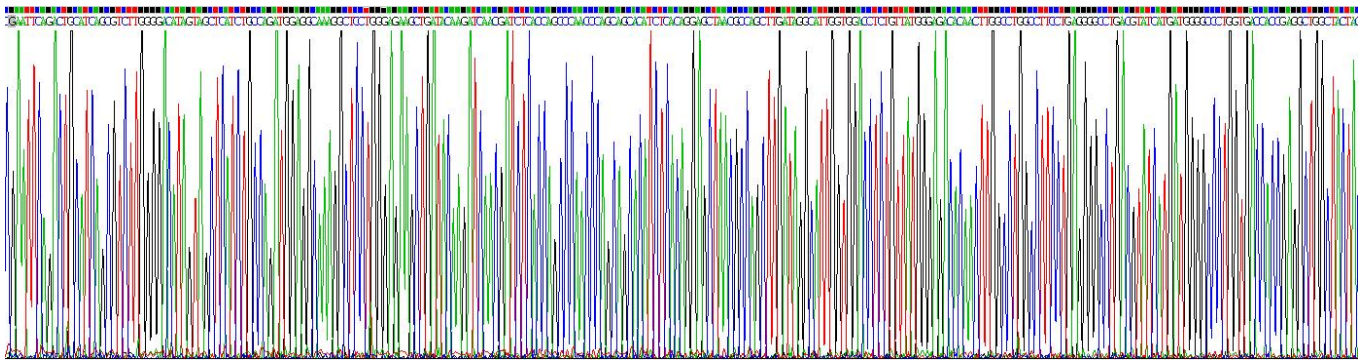
Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.

**Stability Test:** The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

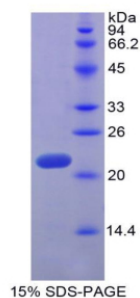
