## [ FORMULATION ]

Form \& Buffer: Supplied as solution form in 0.01 M PBS, pH 7.4 , containing 0.05\% Proclin-300, 50\% glycerol.

## [ QUALITY CONTROL ]

Content: The quality control contains recombinant REG3g disposed in loading buffer.

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Usage: 10uL per well when 3,3'-Diaminobenzidine(DAB) as the substrate. 5uL per well when used in enhanced chemilumescent (ECL).
Note: The quality control is specifically manufactured as the positive control.
Not used for other purposes.
Loading Buffer: 100 mM Tris(pH6.8), $1 \%$ SDS, $150 \mathrm{mM} \mathrm{NaCl}, 50 \%$ glycerol, $0.02 \% \mathrm{BPB}, 50 \mathrm{mM}$ DTT and $0.02 \% \mathrm{NaN}_{3}$.

## [ STORAGE AND STABILITY ]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
Store at $4^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ for frequent use.
Aliquot and store at $-20^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ for 12 months.
Stability Test: The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at $37^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ for 48 h , and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than $5 \%$ within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
