Optimal working dilutions must be determined by end user.

[FORMULATION]

Form & Buffer: Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.02% NaN3, 50% glycerol.

[STORAGE AND STABILITY]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 4°C for frequent use.

Aliquot and store at -20°C for 24 months.



Stability Test: The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.





Figure. Western Blot; Sample: Lane1: Human Serum Tissue; Lane2: Porcine Stomach Tissue.



Human SiHa cell was fixed with 2% paraformaldehyde (10 min), permeabilised with 0.1% BSA-Triton X-100,then stained with 20µg/ml rabbit Anti-human FN Polyclonal Antibody (Catalog PAA037Hu01, red histogram) or Isotype control antibody (Catalog IS067-Rb01, green histogram), followed by 1µg/ml FITC-conjugated Anti-rabbit IgG Secondary Antibody (Catalog SAA544Rb18).
